### **Principal's Report**

- School appreciates the \$8000 it received from Casino Night Fundraiser. football gate which funds various areas of sports very low due to Center forfeiture and school lock down and rescheduling of the Bear River game.
- Mr. E received Administrator of the Year, wanted to thank all involved as he indicated it is a team effort to make the school as successful as it has become.
- March 29 @ 6 pm is the Community Forum, covering Facilities needs for potential bond issue.
- April 7 is Site Community Forum, predominantly for city, police, fire etc to get input for needs of the school.
- Information is being gathered to have detailed information for bond measure so public knows exactly where funds are going.
- CASHEE testing for Sophomores, March 17 and 18, Late start for Juniors and Seniors, Freshman will do some pre CASHEE testing to identify students that need intervention.
- More Zero Period offerings for next year.
- New AP English/AP US History and Accelerated Program being offered. It will be a year long program with the classes being held every other day.
- District will pay for track replacement only. Need donations for repair/replace other areas of the field.
- New form being used in track so students can drive themselves to event. Not permitted to take other students. Cannot be dismissed before the scheduled early dismissal for the team.
