Principal's Report

- Thank you for all the work that FOPHS does.
- Peter reviewed the LCAP: Budget items are under goals and action items.
- Will present to Placer Stakeholders on how the LCAP money is spent
- Took a class on school budgeting: Prop 13 gutted school spending in California
- PSAT is during the week. Will be Wednesday, November 14th. Need parent volunteers to help.
- Tennis courts are the next item in the Placer Athletic Conference to be refurbished. Asking for \$25,000. We still need \$16,000. Need letters of support for tennis courts. Open to the community.
- Chromebooks: Fines for broken chromebooks. Placer paid out \$4500 to fix chromebooks. Not sure what to do about seniors and chromebooks. 300 seniors-looking for ideas about how to sell them or get back fees.
- Hillman Foundation: Have given out over \$12,000 in requests. Some teachers are asking for donations from multiple sources.
- Mrs. Ganskie is due back in January. Mrs. Miller went out on leave for a year with Leukemia. Has a great substitute at this point.
- Bond measure moving forward from the district. Looking for funds for facilities. Including Earl Crabbe gym. Most to Del Oro and Placer. About 80 million dollars.
